Weighins: 8:00 am - 8:45 am at each tournament - a singlet must be worn at weighins

Starting Time: 10:30 am until conclusion

There will be a rules interpretation session immediately before the start of each tournament.

Length of Bouts: Bantam 3-1 periods with 30 second break;
Midget, Novice, Schoolboy & Cadet 3-1 1/2 minute periods with 30 second break;
Elite & Senior Open 3-2 minute periods with 30 second break;
Masters 3 - 1 1/2 minute periods with 30 second break.

Wrestling Rules: Freestyle with positive mark system.

Awards: A.A.U. Championship medals for the top three place winners, Trophies for Team Awards.

Note: **Anyone who withdraws from Qualifying Tournament without completing the bracket will be ineligible to advance to the championships.**

Uniforms: A red and Blue singlet are required or a reversible. No t-shirts or shorts are permitted.

Entry Fee: \$15.00 DO NOT MAIL your application after five days prior to the tournament, Bring it with you, walk-ins accepted. In addition, you must have a 2008 A.A.U. Card. You may apply for your card in advance by following the steps below

A.A.U. CARDS

In order to compete in any A.A.U. event you must be registered with an A.A.U. card. The cost is \$12.00 for the entire year for all age groups except the Senior and Masters Divisions. Senior and Masters card are \$22.00. You may purchase your A.A.U. card in advance by going online to the A.A.U. web page: www.aausports.org Simply sign on the A.A.U. web page and go to the membership area to sign up and pay for your A.A.U. card by using a credit card.

To obtain your A.A.U. card by mail, send a check in the proper amount to the Middle Atlantic A.A.U. wrestling office, PO Box 146, Newport, PA 17074. Phone 717-567-7840. Include a self addressed, stamped envelope and the following information: Name, address, phone number, birthdate and email address. The cost for a coach or volunteer is \$14.00. Allow at least (10) days to receive your card by mail. THERE WILL BE NO CARDS WILL BE ON SALE AT THE TOURNAMENTS.
