The top FOUR place winners in the Regional Tournament advance to the Middle Atlantic Wrestling Associations Eastern National Championships at the Wicomico Civic Center, Salisbury, MD on May 4TH & May 5TH, including open division. There will be a \$15.00 advancement fee to be collected at the Regional Tournament. Fifth and Sixth places are ALTERNATES. An additional 1 lb. weight allowance (2 lb. total) will be given at the Eastern National Championships.
